Parent/Guardian Code of Ethics and Participation Agreement

- I will be responsible for my conduct while at games and practices.
- I will be responsible for the conduct of others who attend team functions in my behalf (friends, relatives, etc).
- I will have my child prompt in attendance to all scheduled games and practices, and further will notify the coaching staff if an emergency arises and my child cannot attend a game or practice.
- I will follow all rules pertaining to the facilities that hold team functions.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, and other team events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will help to provide a sports environment that is free from tobacco, drugs, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all events.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will remember that the game is for the children, not for adults.
- I will pay my invoices on time and understand that my child may be suspended from play if I fail to meet all of my financial and fundraising obligations.
- I understand that my child may be removed from a Cecil Skipjacks team at any time by the team Manager, and that all monies previously received on behalf of my child will be forfeit to the use of Cecil Skipjacks Amateur Athletics, Inc.
- If I elect to remove my child from a Cecil Skipjacks team at any time, all monies previously received on behalf of my child will be forfeit to the use of Cecil Skipjacks Amateur Athletics, Inc.

As a member of a Cecil Skipjacks Amateur Athletics, Inc. organization, I will abide by the above guidelines. I understand that deterring from these guidelines could result in a revocation of my rights as a member.
